

SUPERVISOR QUALIFICATIONS

QUALIFICATIONS FOR EXAMINATION SUPERVISOR

Supervisor: To serve as an Examination Supervisor the following qualifications are required:

- Fellow or Associate of the Society of Actuaries (SOA) or of the Casualty Actuarial Society (CAS); or of the Canadian Institute of Actuaries (CIA), or of the Institute of Actuaries (England), or of the Faculty of Actuaries (Scotland), or
- At a minimum, the person should be sufficiently advanced in the examination system to have demonstrated a firm commitment to the actuarial profession. No individuals may supervise an exam for which they do not have credit; or
- If an appropriate member of the SOA as detailed above, is not on staff, someone who has administered standardized tests, such as a tenured academic, or an employee of an insurance company/educational institution (e.g. personnel or training department), or the local testing representative at the United States Embassy is acceptable as the Examination Supervisor.
